(INDIA), NABL accredited laboratory is approved by the Additional Director General (Delhi) CPWD for testing of Building & Roads construction material in Civil, Electrical, Mechanical and Chemical, NDT in all ongoing & upcoming works as per scope of accreditation of NABL for CPWD works for a period of Two Years from the date of issue of this letter, subject to following conditions:-

1) The approval is granted for a period of Two years subject to validity of NABL approval.

2) The approval will automatically lapse after the expiry of NABL approval unless

got renewed.

3) Approval can be withdrawn prematurely without assigning any reasons on complaints or uncalled- for action of the lab.

4) The approval does not absolve the supervisory officer of CPWD of their

responsibility ensuring quality of work.

5) The approval does not make the firm eligible for claiming right to take the work done through them which is subjected to their competitive stand amongst other qualifying specialized firm in the field to avail material testing facilities and discretion of the field units.

6) Field staff may witness the testing if so required by them.

7) The performance of the firm shall be watched by field units and submitted to the approving authority before expiry of validity of approval.

8) This approval shall be applicable for the jurisdiction of Additional Director

General (Delhi), CPWD, Delhi.

9) The rate of testing of material should not be more than central or state government institution/ laboratory and market rate whichever is less. Field officer should check these rates before placing the order for testing.

10) The laboratory shall retain the balance material after testing for at least thirty

days from the date of report sent to the department.

11)On receiving the samples, the lab shall perform the tests within prescribed period as per CPWD specifications/BIS or other relevant codes/standards and shall submit the test results/ reports within three days of conducting test.

12) The lab shall report to the acknowledgment of receipt of sample on same day via e-mail at official e-mail id of concerned AE/EE/SE/CE and contractor. Soft copy in PDF format of test report shall be sent to the official e-mail IDs of the concerned offices on the date of issue of test report as well as hard copy in original to the Engineer-in charge of the work and contractor.

13) The laboratory is liable to be debarred for a minimum period of one year in case any adverse remarks are received against the laboratory or repeated delays in issue of test reports for more than seven days, are reported by

Executive Engineer to the approval authority.

14) M/s STELLAR TEST HOUSE, G-68, Sector-63, Noida-201301, U.P. (INDIA), shall have valid calibration certificate of equipments/machines from NABL approved authority during this period of validity.
